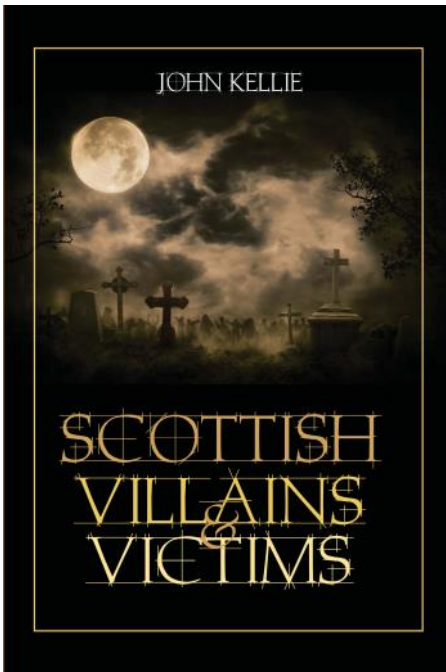

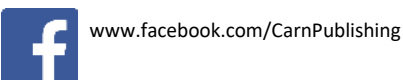
ABOUT THE AUTHOR
